The Tithe - our Mission Giving

Every year your PCC tithes its income at All Saints to support Mission outside our Parish. Donations received in the numbered giving envelopes and standing orders are identified as **Planned Giving** and ten percent of the total is allocated to the Tithe. The recipients may change from year to year but for 2025 this tithe was given to five 'missions'

These are **Church Pastoral Aid Society** (CPAS), **Scripture Union**, **Bible Society**, **Release International** and **Salvation Army (Goldthorpe Food Bank)**. The amount is calculated on the figures shown in the previous year's accounts and the tithe for 2025 was £2,400 which meant that each received £480. We have now received thank you letters which are on the noticeboard at the back of church and include the following snippets –

From Scripture Union – "You are such a blessing to us. Your donation is helping children and young people find God and begin a spiritual journey with him. Thank you helping to reveal Jesus to even more children and young people not in church."

From CPAS – "With your continued support, our Leadership Development Team will be able to equip church leaders across the UK for local mission through resources, online webinars, and training courses. Your kind donation plays a vital role in in making life-changing discipleship holidays possible, giving children and young people the opportunity to grow in faith."

From Release International – "Our magazine shares the stories of Christians in Nigeria, Iran, Armenia and Pakistan. Your gift could help provide packs of essentials such as food and hygiene supplies to those who have been attacked. It could help fund trauma healing workshops in Nigeria or support the work of Strength to Stand groups in Pakistan and Egypt. Thank you for your support which means we can continue to love and serve our persecuted brothers and sisters".

From The Bible Society – "I just wanted to write a little note to thank you for the recent financial donation. We really do appreciate you partnering with us in our mission. May God bless you as a community".

We hope to have speakers from these various missions at some of our Sunday Services. The first will be from CPAS in January – watch out for details nearer the time.

Tithing

The principles of tithing were set out by the LORD in Deuteronomy 14: 22. "Be sure to set aside a tenth of all that your fields produce each year". This was to support the Levitical Priesthood and Religious Feasts, and to aid the poor, fatherless, and widows. Even earlier, Abraham and Jacob had established the principle. Abraham gave 'a tenth of everything' to Melchizedek, King of Salem who was a Priest of God Most High in return for a blessing [Genesis 14: 18-20]. Following his dream of a stairway linking Earth to Heaven and the LORD's Covenant with him that his descendants would inhabit that area, Jacob vowed to the LORD that "of all that you give me I will give you a tenth." [Genesis 28: 10-22]. How do we match up to this principle?
