

Christ the King: The Sunday next before Advent.

The four Sundays before Advent are described as **Kingdomtide** where we concentrate on the true Kingship of Christ. The Feast of Christ the King was instituted in the early 20th Century and this Sunday marks the end, for a while, of what is known as **Ordinary Time.** Next week, on **Advent Sunday**, we will begin a new liturgical year in the life of the Church. We will then in succession mark the feasts of Advent, Christmas, Epiphany, Lent and Easter before returning to Ordinary Time after Trinity.

Those of us familiar with the Book of Common Prayer will know this Sunday as the Twenty-fifth Sunday after Trinity or the Sunday next before Advent. The opening phrase – "**Stir up we beseech Thee O Lord**" gave rise to family customs of making the Christmas Puddings. These words are intended to inspire the faithful to be mindful of the season where we look forward to hear once more the accounts of the birth of Jesus in our world. In our Carol services, the readings and carols will remind us of this and some of the many references to the promised Messiah from the Old Testament.

God the Father, help us to hear the call of Christ the King and to follow in His service, whose kingdom has no end; for He reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, one glory.
