

Resumption of Public Worship

After many months of being unable to worship in our Churches, we are now able to move slowly towards meeting together in person. From January 2021, a temporary pattern of services will mean that each of the three Parishes in our Mission Partnership will have a Communion Service each week but not every Sunday. The numbers allowed at each service will be limited and bookings will have to be made in advance for 'a pew' which may be for an individual, Family Group or Bubble. The pattern will start from **3rd January 2021** with a service **in All Saints at 9:00 a.m.** Bookings as for Christmas Eve

We will be holding a Service of Holy Communion on Christmas Eve at 6:00 p.m. in the Parish Church of All Saints. The dictionary entry is... a Joyous Song, especially a Christmas Hymn. They were popular as dance songs in the twelfth Century and as processional songs from the fourteenth Century. Today's hymns and songs are all carols but we tend to relate the name to songs for Advent, Christmas and, to a lesser extent, Easter.

Many of our Christmas Carols were written in the 18th and 19th Centuries but amongst the oldest is the Coventry Carol. This was part of The Nativity, in the Medieval Coventry Mystery Plays and related the events

from the Annunciation to the Slaughter of the Innocents. It was sung by three women of Bethlehem immediately after Joseph has been warned in a dream to take his family to safety in Egypt.

Christmas 2020 will be one of the strangest that most of us have experienced. We are unable to join with our Community in our Carols by Candlelight Service and hear the familiar story and sing what may have included your favourite carol.

On **Tuesday 22nd December at 7:00 p.m.,** we urge you to join with our congregation as we rediscover the **Loving Purposes of God** with passages from the Bible and some well loved carols. All of you will have a printed copy of the Service of Lessons and Carols and could join with us in spirit on that evening even if you cannot join us online with Zoom.

This season gives us the chance to celebrate God's greatest gift to us in His Son Jesus. As we see the Christmas decorations around our streets, let us pray that they will radiate the true light of Jesus and that many will come to know the true Joy of Christmas and of Jesus.
